## User Scenarios Policy

### Rationale

As a group we have all spent time in one way or another re-skinning other people's shapes, using other people's resources to create scenarios and planting other people's assets to create routes. Since the dawn of Train Simming this has been a way of life and is the way that people have developed the skills we see today.

As a consequence of this we feel strongly that we should support others in their desire to create their own little part of the simulation world. Our User Scenarios Policy is a part of this desire.

### Overview

To assist those who enjoy the creation of scenarios to share their work and to enable those who are relatively new to the hobby to track down additional scenarios that feature items they have purchased we have set aside an area of the website for the distribution of scenarios that feature our stock packs.

In general the section is divided into three types of scenario:

- Scenarios that feature one Fastline Simulation stock pack along with default rolling stock on a default route.
- Scenarios that feature multiple Fastline Simulation stock packs along with default rolling stock on a default or Fastline Simulation route.
- Scenarios that feature one or more Fastline Simulation stock packs along with other third party rolling stock on a default, Fastline Simulation or third party route.

### Submission of Scenarios

Scenarios for inclusion in the library should be emailed as an attachment to [submissions@fastline-simulation.co.uk](mailto:submissions@fastline-simulation.co.uk)

In emailing a scenario for submission you implicitly accept the licensing conditions and other requirements set out in this document.

### Submission Requirements

In submitting a file for inclusion you declare that the work included is all your own work or on the part of a group effort you have the full agreement of the group to submit the file.

You should include the scenario package file in a zip archive that contains a readme file pertaining to the activity. You should also send an image to illustrate the scenario as a separate file not contained in the archive.

The readme file should be in a universal format (e.g. pdf, txt, rtf) and should contain the following information:

- Activity creator name
- Contact details or where to go for support
- Critical information for the use of the scenario including any additional files that are required by the user.

The readme file may also include:

- Installation instructions
- Driving hints and tips
- Timetable
- Further information the scenario creator feels may assist the end user.

### Downloading Scenarios

The submitted scenarios will be made available for download without registration through the Fastline Simulation website at [www.fastline-simulation.co.uk](http://www.fastline-simulation.co.uk) .

## **Support**

The scenarios that are made available for download are supplied 'as is' and Fastline Simulation Ltd. offers no support in the use of the scenarios other than in the event of the inability to download the file.

All other support will be dealt with by the creator of the file as set out in the readme file included in the download package.

## **Exclusivity**

We do not require exclusivity for the hosting of any file and they may be freely uploaded to any other website, the hosting service is merely an additional opportunity for individuals to share their work.

## **Removal of Scenarios**

If you wish your files to be removed from our server for any reason simply email [submissions@fastline-simulation.co.uk](mailto:submissions@fastline-simulation.co.uk) and we will remove them as quickly as possible and strive to do this in less than 72 hours from the receipt of notification.

This process should also be followed if you think someone has submitted your work without your permission.

## **Licensing Conditions**

In submitting a scenario the individual responsible will have implicitly implied their consent to the terms of this policy.

Any submitted files remain the property of the owner and are only hosted on the website. Files may be removed at the owners request as outlined above.

In hosting the files and making them available for download Fastline Simulation Ltd take no responsibility and accept no liability for any issues, damage or data loss caused by the download or use of the files.

Users will have agreed to the terms in this policy along with any other reasonable terms on the part of the scenario creator at the time of download.
